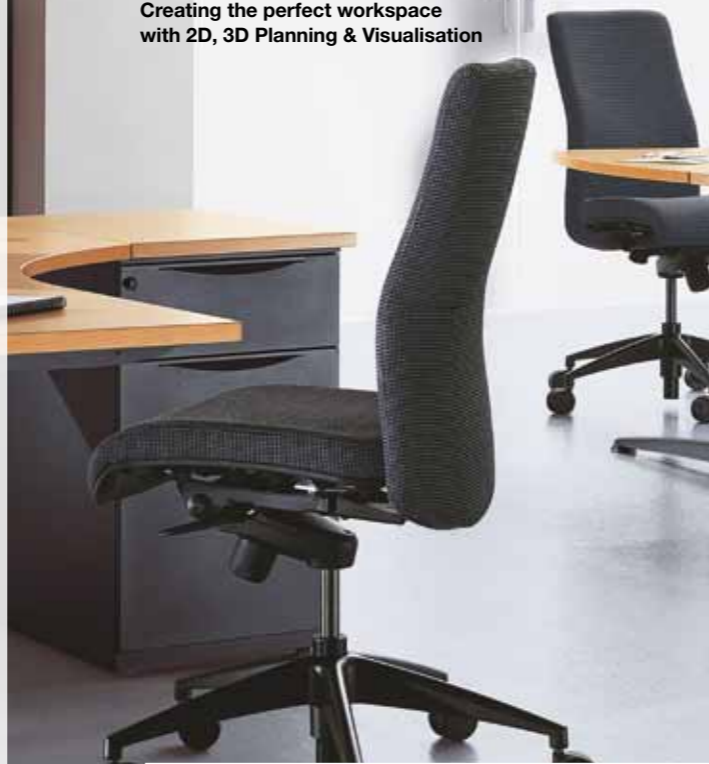

Desktop screens are available in many different shapes, sizes and colours and normally used in offices to divide working space and give a little privacy whilst still enabling group interaction.

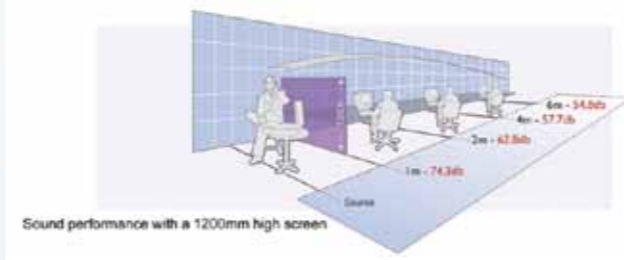
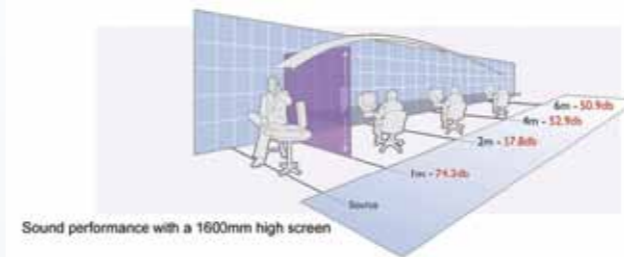
Glazed Screens

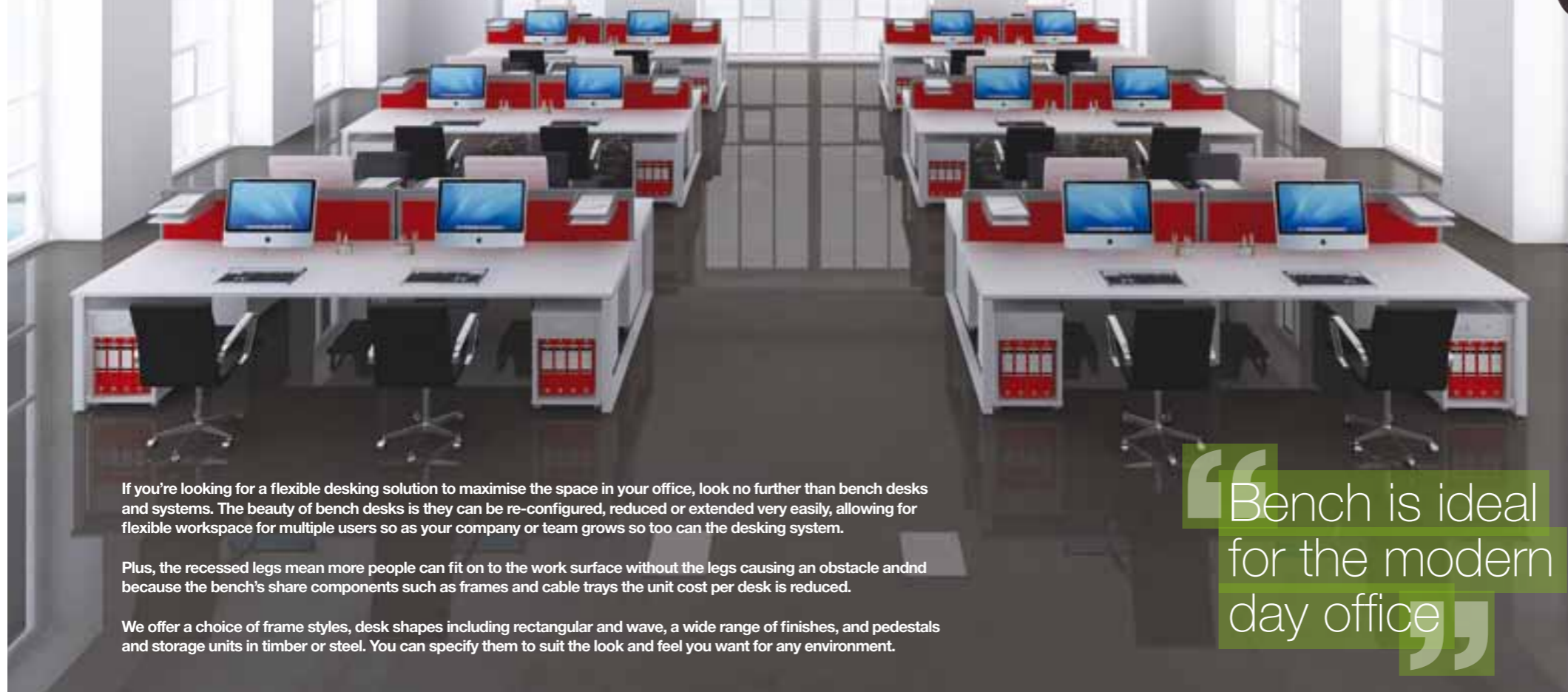
